UPCOMING SPEAKERS

16th July 2019 Our speaker is Pete Ceglinski, CEO & Co Founder of the “Seabin Project”. He was recently on ABC radio discussing a new project – developing solutions for cleaner and more sustainable marinas, rivers and public waterways. He is currently advising the Tweed Shire Council on the Seabin V5 as a debris intercepting device for mismanaged waste, plastic & micro fibers before they reach the open sea.



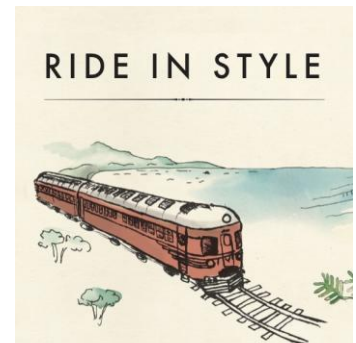
It’s no secret that our oceans are heavily polluted with plastic rubbish, and the problem is only growing. TheNational Geographic reports that the world’s plastic production increased from 2.3 million tonnes in 1950 to a whopping 448 million tonnes by 2015. It is estimated that the ocean will contain more plastics than fish (by weight) by 2050. With these statistics, the future looks bleak.

The creators of Seabin aim to use their invention to collect and reduce the amount of plastic in the ocean, and create awareness around the issue. The bins are being strategically placed in Australia, and in 23 countries around the world.

Friday 14th June 2019 [VISIT TO RAAF AMBERLEY BASE](#) Located 40kms south-west of Brisbane on the outskirts of Ipswich. **This is a long day out! BUS IS FULL.**
Pickup at Casuarina at 7.10am sharp and 7.30am from Pottsville market site.

Morning tea will be at Ipswich Information Centre, then 20 minutes to Base, arriving 10.00am. Cameras & smartphones **MUST** be turned off as we approach the base but you do **NOT** have to surrender them. **EXCITING NEWS – SOME AREAS CAN BE PHOTOGRAPHED**, when given permission. Our military escort will board our bus - we must follow all instructions.

Please wear your PROBUS ID – this is an important additional security measure.



- We will be on the Base for 2 hours.
- 90% sure to see the C17A Globemaster
 - may be able to drive the bus out to Globemaster
 - 35 Squadron which conducts Overseas Operations and Border Protection, will be open for inspection
 - may be possible to see ground facilities which includes fire fighting equipment, and anything else we can possibly fit in to the 2 hours.
- Lunch will be at own expense at Ipswich Jets Leagues Club, special \$16.00 menu available, or you can choose a la carte.
 Scenic drive home with late afternoon arrival.

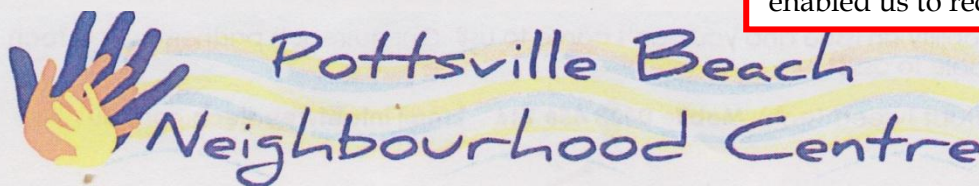
