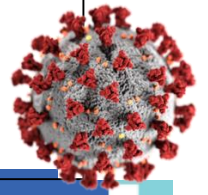

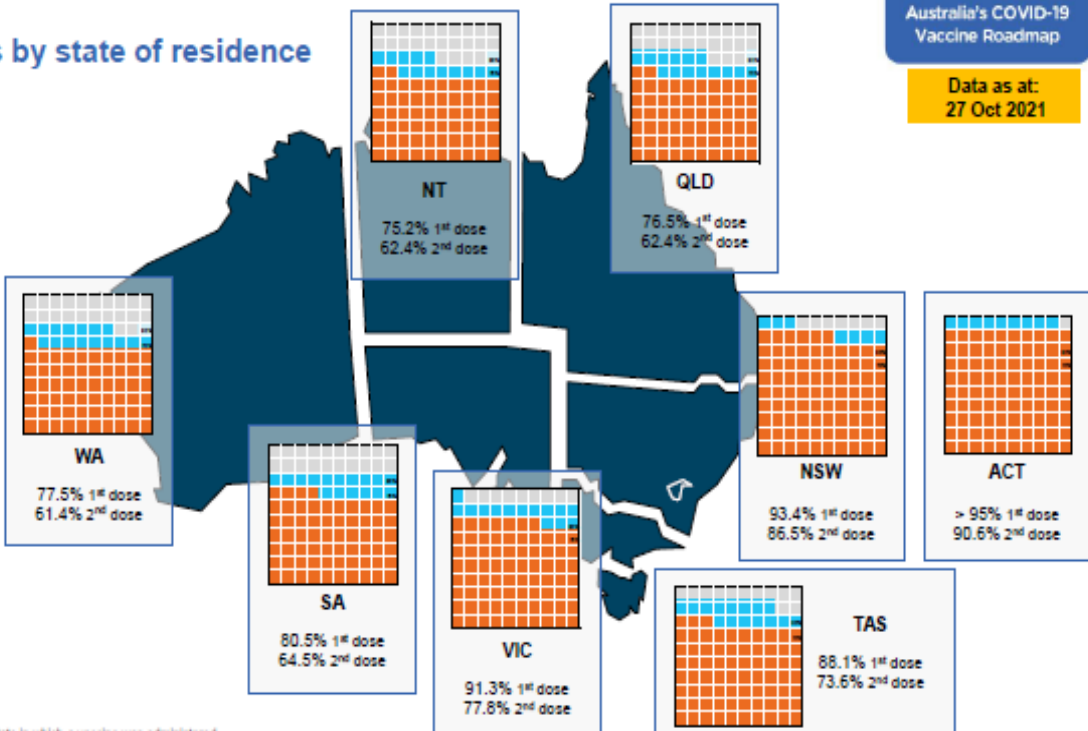


Australia's COVID-19 Vaccine Roadmap
