HAPPY NEW YEAR!

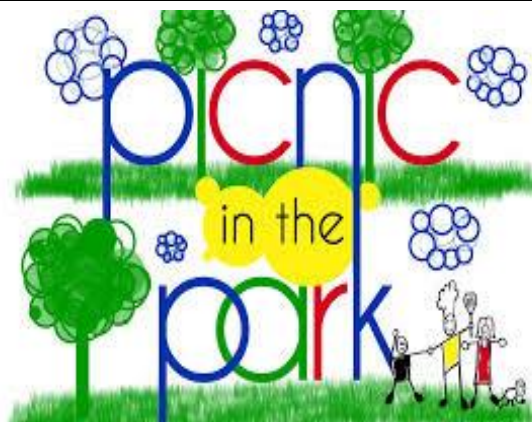
