# Just what you wanted to know.....

The Queen's Birthday public holiday will officially be known as the King's Birthday public holiday from 2023, so the King's Birthday public holiday will fall on Monday June 12, despite his actual birth date being 14<sup>th</sup> November 1948.

The Public Holidays Act 2010 amendment has been gazetted and will be effective as of January 13, 2023.

Although Queen Elizabeth II's actual birth date was April 21 1926, in keeping with Royal tradition, official celebrations in the UK were held in June when there was a greater likelihood of fine weather for the Birthday Parade or Trooping of the Colour.

NSW followed in that tradition, with the holiday falling on the second Monday in June.

## Guest speaker for 20th June will be Craig Hobart, a Gold Coast pilot for Angel Flight.



Angel Flight was established in 2003 by pilot and businessman Bill Bistrow, to service rural and remote communities. This is a charity that provides non-emergency flights free of charge for disadvantaged patients needing travel to/from distant medical treatment, or transport of medical products.

The service does not supply medical staff or services, as an alternative to those provided by the Royal Flying Doctor Service or Air Ambulance.

Angel Fight is funded by private donations and philanthropic organisations. And flights are provided by volunteer pilots using their own aircraft.

Sounds like an amazing service that we know very little about!
