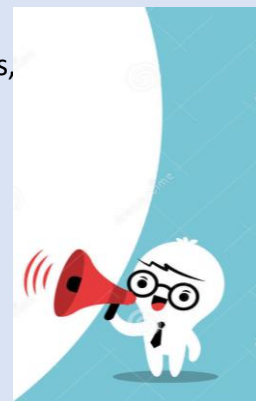
June - **Joanne Austen Brown** from Glen Innes, author of historic romance novels

Tri Care residents appreciate your consideration.

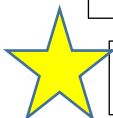
We are all in that vulnerable age group (check your birth certificate), so now is the time to ensure that all your vaccinations are up to date. Flu and Covid should be done by now.
